



Resolution No. R2009-85

A Resolution of the Pierce County Council and Executive Commemorating the 100 Year Anniversary of Wilcox Family Farms.

Whereas, Wilcox Family Farms was founded in 1909 in Roy, Washington, and today is a fourth generation, family-run business dedicated to producing incredibly fresh egg products; and

Whereas, Wilcox Family Farms is the first company to earn Food Alliance certification for egg production and processing and is home to over 800,000 laying hens, several hundred thousand pullets, a shell egg processing plant and a liquid egg processing plant; and

Whereas, approximately 770,000 organic eggs are gathered daily and packaged for supermarkets and restaurants in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Alaska and Canada; and

Whereas, in addition to shell egg products, Wilcox Family Farms provides over 150,000 pounds of liquid eggs per week to bakeries and food service operations; and

Whereas, Wilcox Family Farms is committed to providing a first class program for food service customers that includes customer service, innovation, research and marketing; **Now, Therefore**,

BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Council and Executive of Pierce County:


The Council and Executive recognize and congratulate Wilcox Family Farms on its 100 Year Anniversary.






